Create a colorful 16-panel celebrity or character expression grid from one reference image.

MAIN PROMPT

Copy this entire prompt

Replace both [CELEBRITY OR PERSON] placeholders before sending.

Create one finished, full-color 4 x 4 photobooth expression grid featuring [CELEBRITY OR PERSON]. Use the uploaded reference image as the main identity anchor and preserve the person's recognizable facial structure, skin tone, hairstyle, hairline, facial hair, age, and overall appearance across every panel.

The final image must be vertical in a 9:16 aspect ratio and contain exactly 16 evenly sized portrait panels arranged in four rows and four columns. Separate the panels with thin, clean white gutters. Show only one person in the entire grid. Keep the camera angle, framing, lens look, lighting, hairstyle, and clothing consistent from panel to panel.

Dress the person in a plain black T-shirt with no logos, graphics, text, jewelry, or visible branding. Frame each panel as a tight head-and-shoulders portrait, photographed with a natural 50 mm portrait look. Keep the eyes sharply focused and the face centered. Surprised expression with wide eyes and the mouth slightly open. 11. Excited fake scream or shout with both hands close to the face. 12. Mischievous grin with both hands posed like playful claws. 13. Keep the person's identity extremely consistent in all 16 panels. Every panel must clearly look like the same person, not a similar person or a different version of them. Maintain realistic facial anatomy, symmetrical eyes, natural teeth, correct mouth shape, and believable hands. Give special attention to fingers and hand placement.

Do not include extra fingers, missing fingers, deformed hands, warped faces, uneven eyes, melted mouths, duplicate expressions, duplicate panels, multiple people, mixed identities, logos, text, captions, watermarks, props, cinematic backgrounds, dramatic side lighting, blur, low resolution, or artificial-looking skin.

Generate exactly one complete grid for [CELEBRITY OR PERSON]. Do not create several grids, several celebrities, or separate images. Complete this one person first, then wait for the next request.

Open ChatGPT

Use the ChatGPT app or ChatGPT directly in your browser.

2

Upload one clear reference image

Choose a sharp headshot where the face and hairstyle are easy to see.

3

Paste the full prompt

Replace [CELEBRITY OR PERSON] with the exact person you want.

4

Generate the complete grid

Wait until the 4 x 4 image is finished before requesting another person.

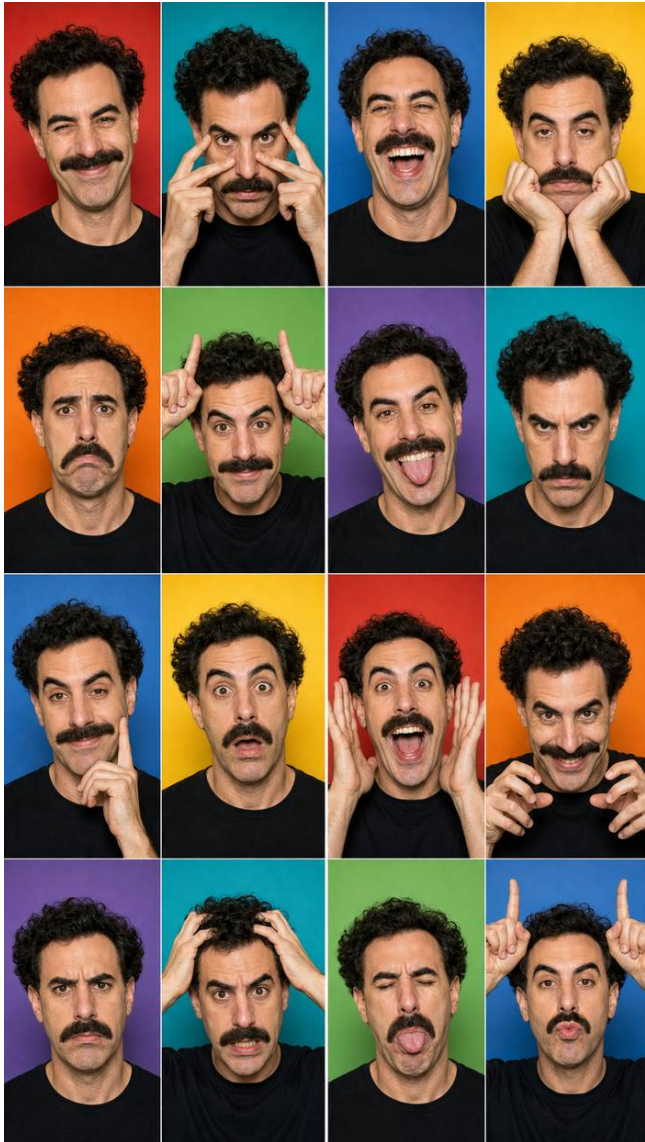
Why direct use in ChatGPT is more reliable

A separate browser-control agent can lose the upload, click the wrong control, time out, refresh the page, or stop before the image is finished. Keeping the upload, instructions, and generation inside one ChatGPT conversation removes those extra failure points. It improves workflow reliability, although it does not guarantee that every public-figure request will be accepted.

Best practice

Use one reference image, one person, and one finished grid per request. Send the next celebrity or person only after the current image has completed.
