

Paper Style Reel Workflow

Turn a raw talking-head clip into a mixed-media collage reel with paper cutout styling, stop-motion feel, kinetic text, doodles, and paper-style transitions.

What this workflow covers

- Restyle the video into a bold paper / collage look.
- Keep the original motion, timing, and voice intact.
- Add zooms, angle changes, kinetic text, doodles, and paper SFX.

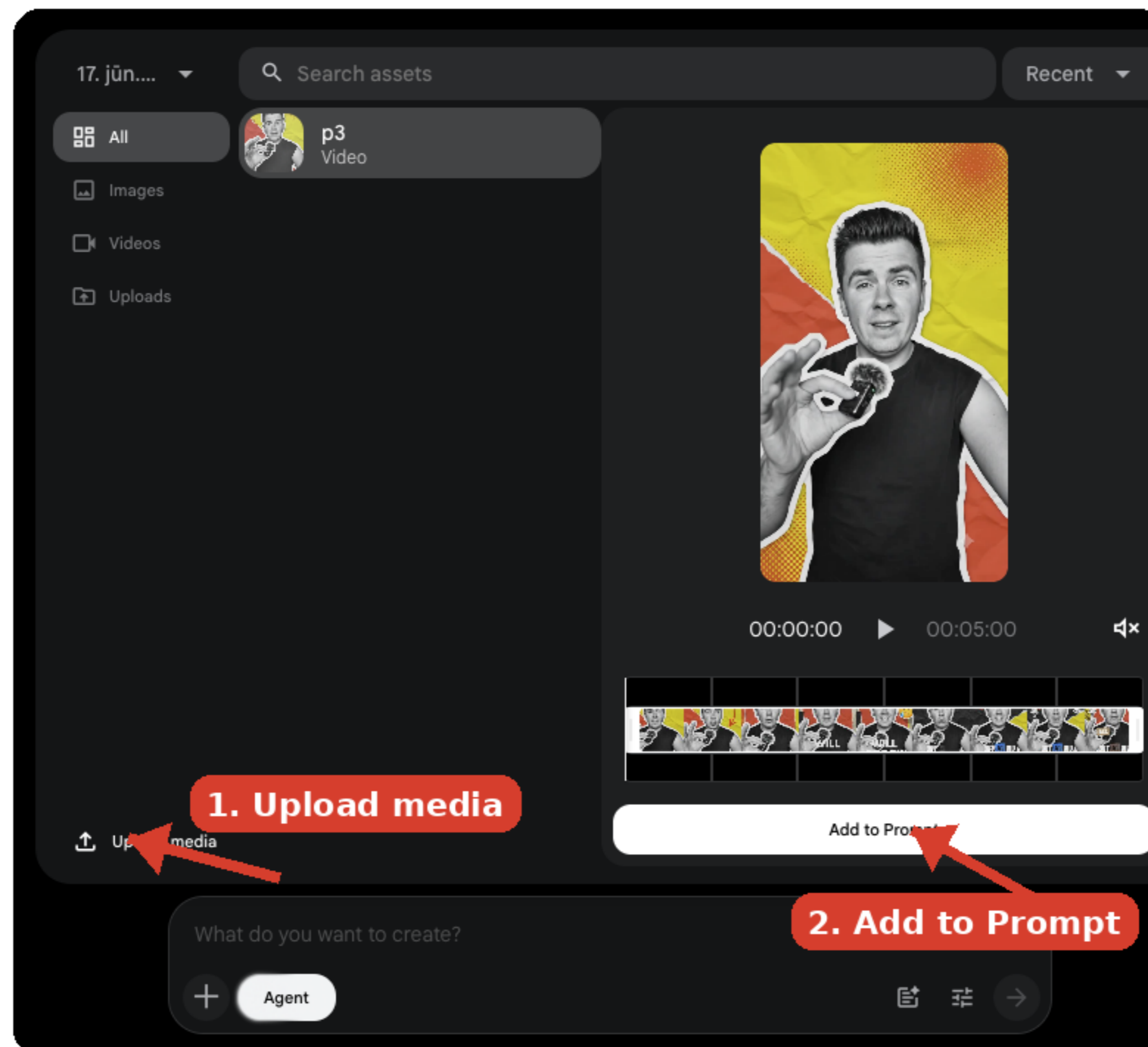

Workflow Step 1

Upload the source video

Step 1 — Upload the video

Upload your talking-head source clip, then select the clip and click Add to Prompt.



What to do here

- Open Google Omni / Flow and upload your raw talking-head video.
- In the asset panel, select the clip you want to restyle.
- Click Add to Prompt so the clip becomes the source video for the edit.
- The cleaner the source clip, the cleaner the paper-cutout result.

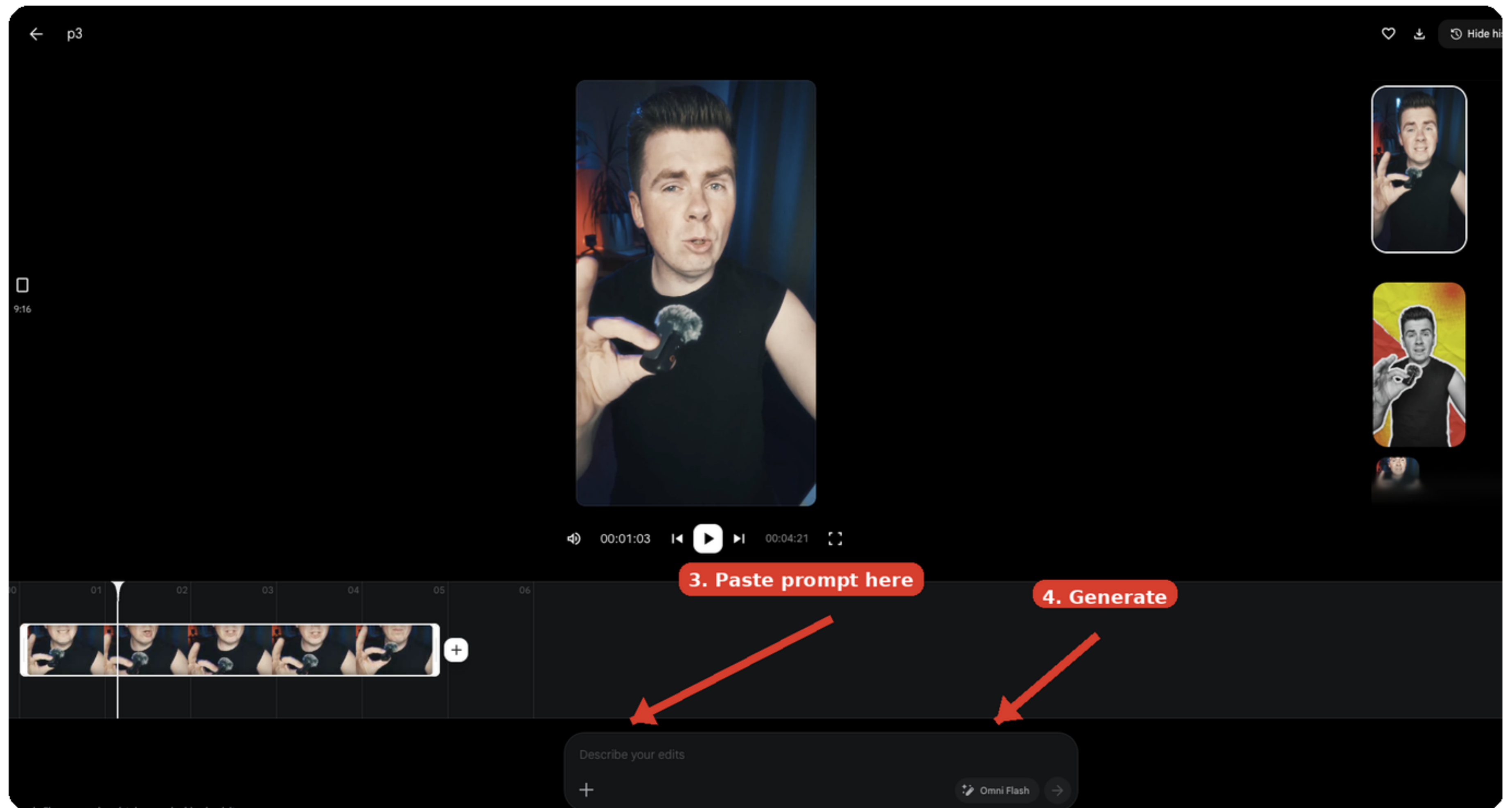
Target look: red + acid yellow + black, paper textures, newspaper scraps, halftone dots.

Workflow Step 2

Paste prompt and generate

Step 2 — Paste the prompt and generate

Paste the prompt into the edit box, then generate. Use your full captions so the text sync is accurate.



What the result should feel like

Paper collage look

Subject cut out with a rough paper edge, layered over crumpled paper, newspaper scraps, and halftone backgrounds.

Dynamic motion

Zoom-ins, zoom-outs, angle changes, and a choppy stop-motion energy.

Audio + text sync

Big bold words should appear exactly in sync with the speech, and paper sound effects should match transitions.

Important: use your full captions in the prompt so Google Omni can line up the big paper-style titles with your spoken words.
