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MAXFUSION UGC AI VIDEO WORKFLOW

How to generate ultra-realistic UGC-style AI videos inside Maxfusion AI.

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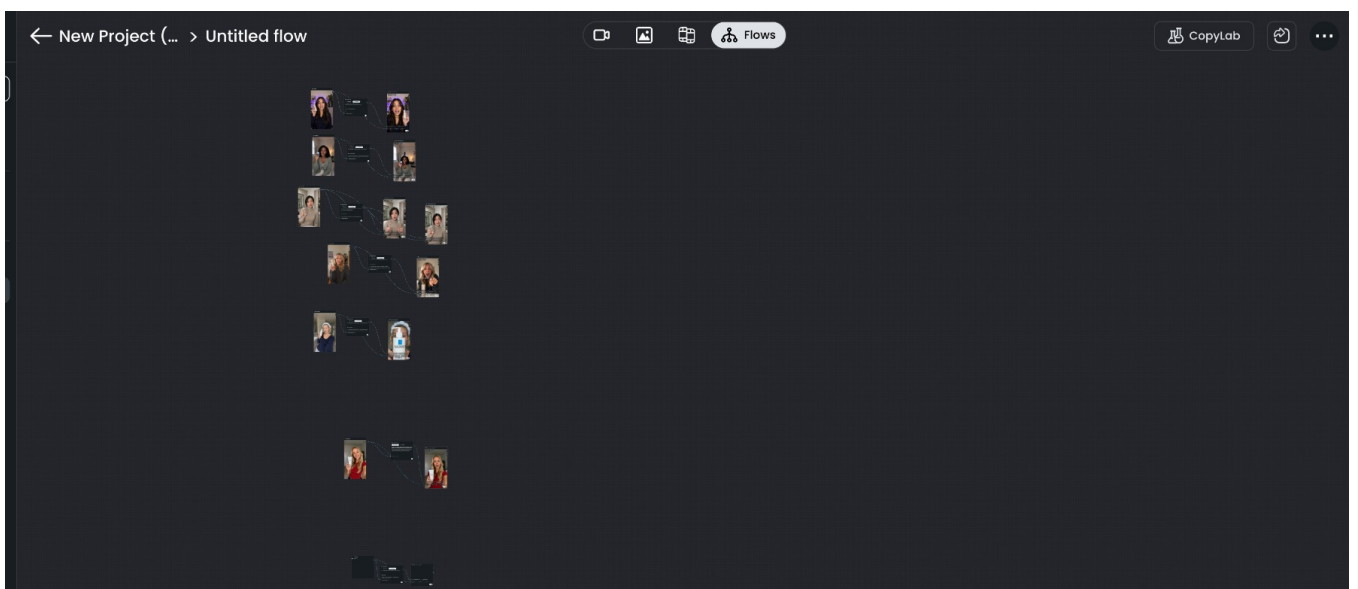

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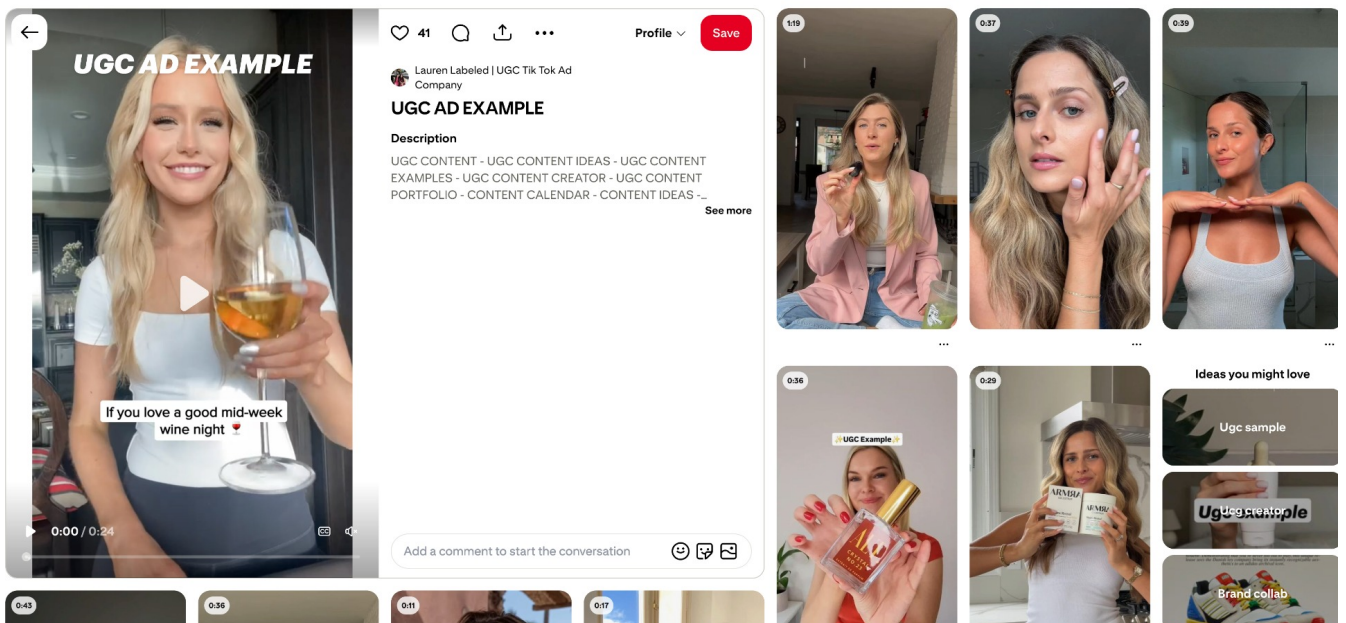


Maxfusion flow canvas: image/reference -> assistant prompt -> Seedance video generator.

THE SIMPLE IDEA

Build a realistic UGC reference image, then turn it into a short AI ad with a strong hook.

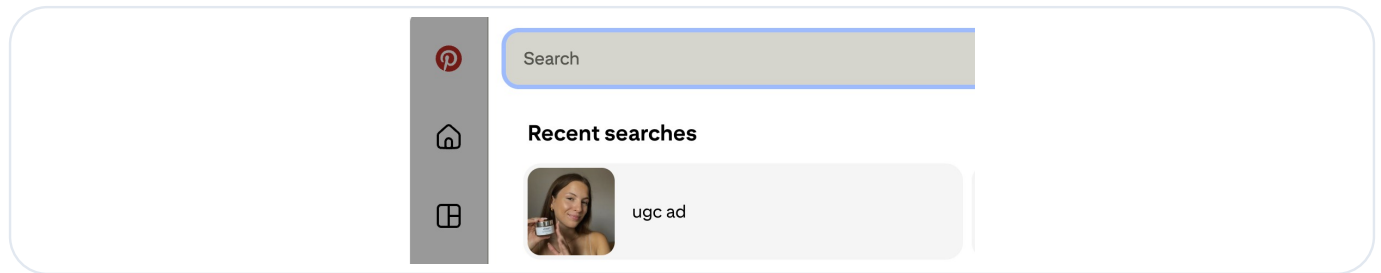
- Start with a realistic UGC creator image: upload a reference, use a Pinterest-style UGC example, or generate one inside Maxfusion.
- Write a short Assistant prompt asking for a 10-15 second UGC ad with many cuts, a strong hook, natural product explanation, and one funny attention moment.
- Connect the Image/Reference and Assistant output into the Video Generator. Use Seedance 2.0, vertical 9:16, 720p, 10-15 seconds.



Use UGC examples only as structure inspiration: hook, framing, product placement, captions, and pacing.

STEP 1 - FIND OR CREATE A UGC REFERENCE

Search for UGC ad structure, then recreate the vibe in Maxfusion.

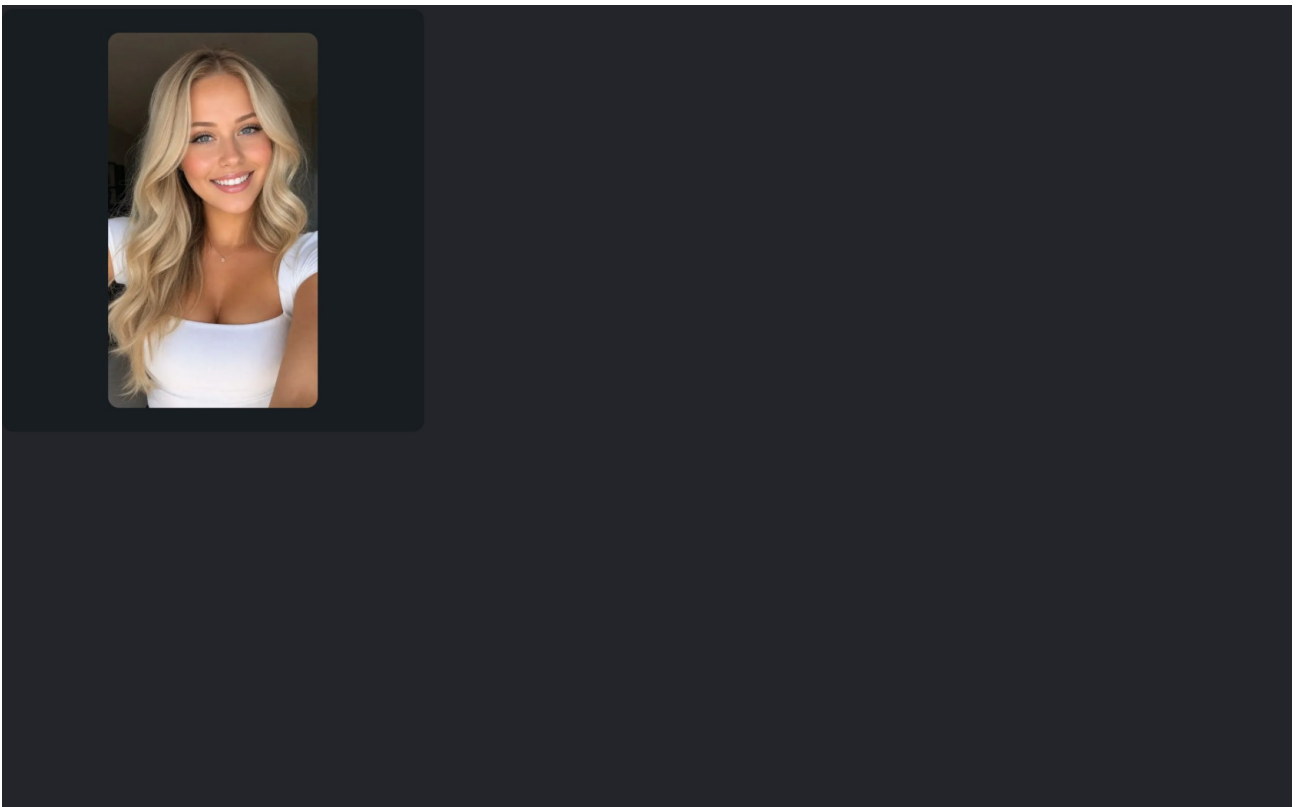


Search example: "ugc ad" on Pinterest.

IMAGE PROMPT FOR MAXFUSION / GPT IMAGE 2

Create a realistic vertical iPhone-style UGC ad image of a young woman holding a skincare product close to the camera.

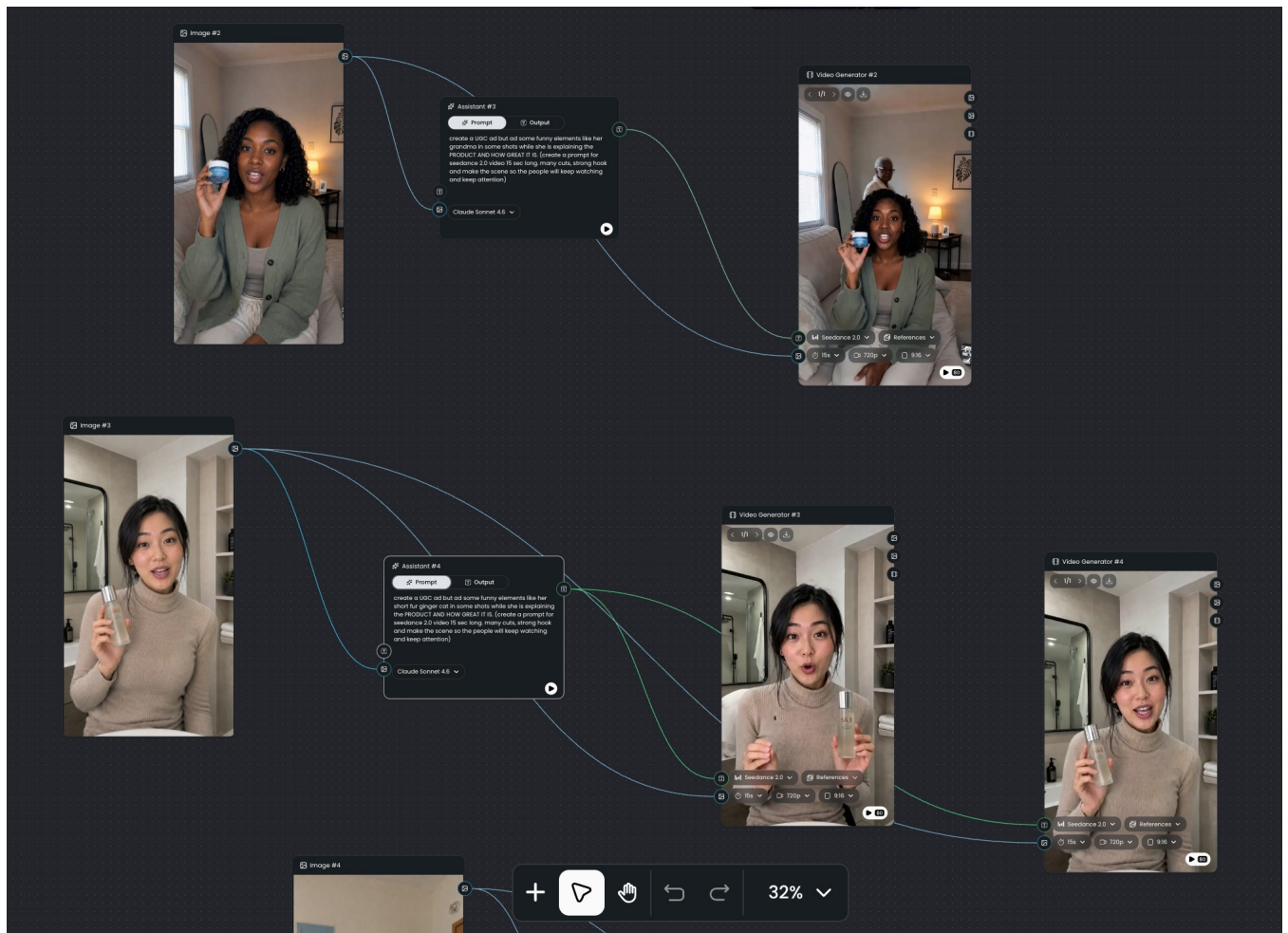
Natural indoor bedroom or bathroom lighting, casual creator energy, realistic skin texture, soft expression, simple outfit, product visible, social-media UGC aesthetic, 9:16 frame, not cinematic, not overly polished.



You can generate the UGC creator reference directly in Maxfusion using GPT Image 2.

STEP 2 - BUILD THE FLOW IN MAXFUSION

Use nodes: Image -> Assistant -> Video Generator.



Connect the uploaded/generated image into the Assistant and Video Generator nodes.

- Upload or generate your UGC creator image in an Image node.
- Add an Assistant node and write the ad direction.
- Send the Assistant output into the Video Generator prompt input.
- Send the Image node into the Video Generator reference input.

STEP 3 - USE THIS ASSISTANT PROMPT

This is the simple prompt visible in the Maxfusion workflow screenshots.

ASSISTANT NODE PROMPT

Create a UGC ad but add some funny elements in shots while she is explaining the PRODUCT and how great it is. Create a prompt for Seedance 2.0 video, 15 sec long. Use many cuts, a strong hook, and make the scene so people keep watching and keep attention.

STRONGER VARIATION

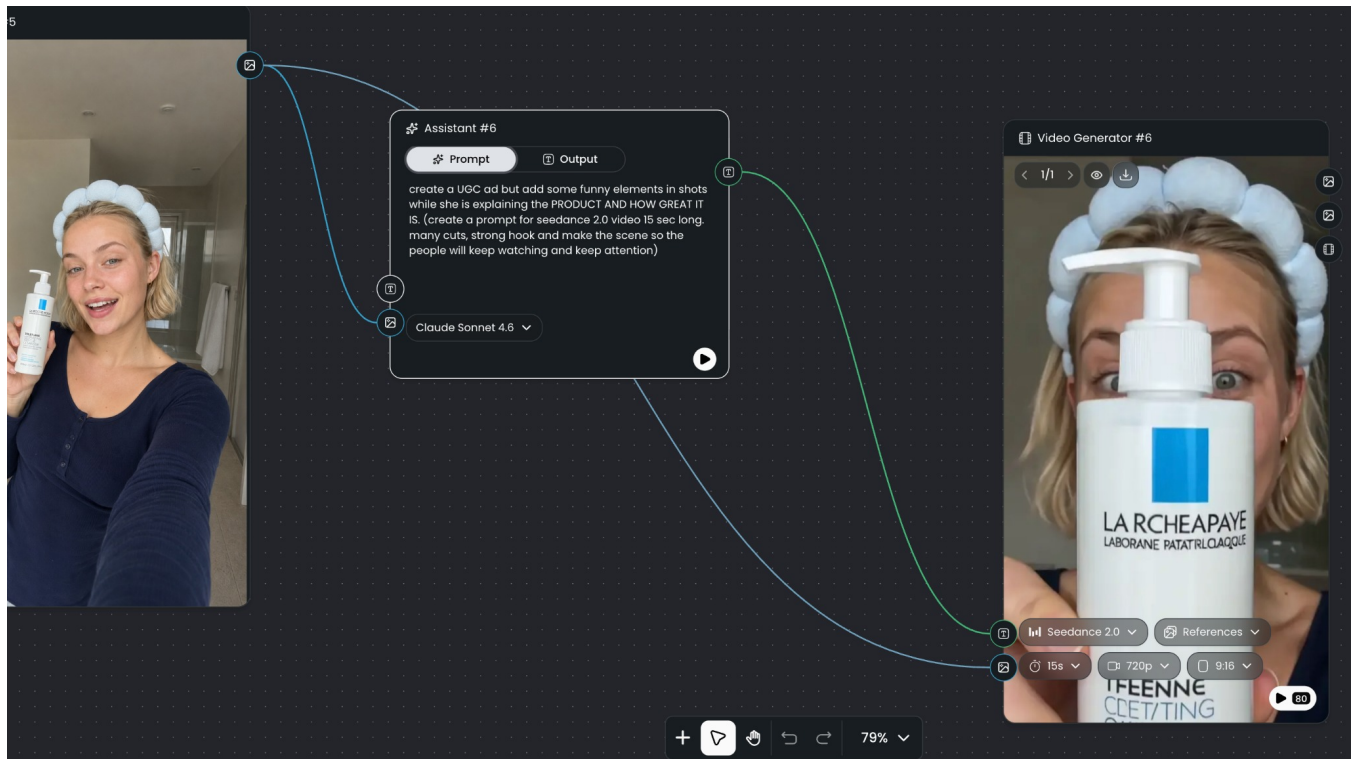
Create a UGC ad but add a funny twist: while the creator is explaining the product, unexpected little things happen in the background or foreground. Keep the product visible, keep the creator realistic, use fast cuts, strong facial reactions, natural UGC dialogue, and a hook in the first second. Make it feel like a real TikTok/Instagram UGC ad, not a polished commercial.



Example: exaggerated reaction + bold subtitle style helps keep attention.

STEP 4 - VIDEO GENERATOR SETTINGS

Use the same basic settings shown in your Maxfusion project.



Video Generator: Seedance 2.0, references connected, vertical 9:16, 720p, 15 seconds.

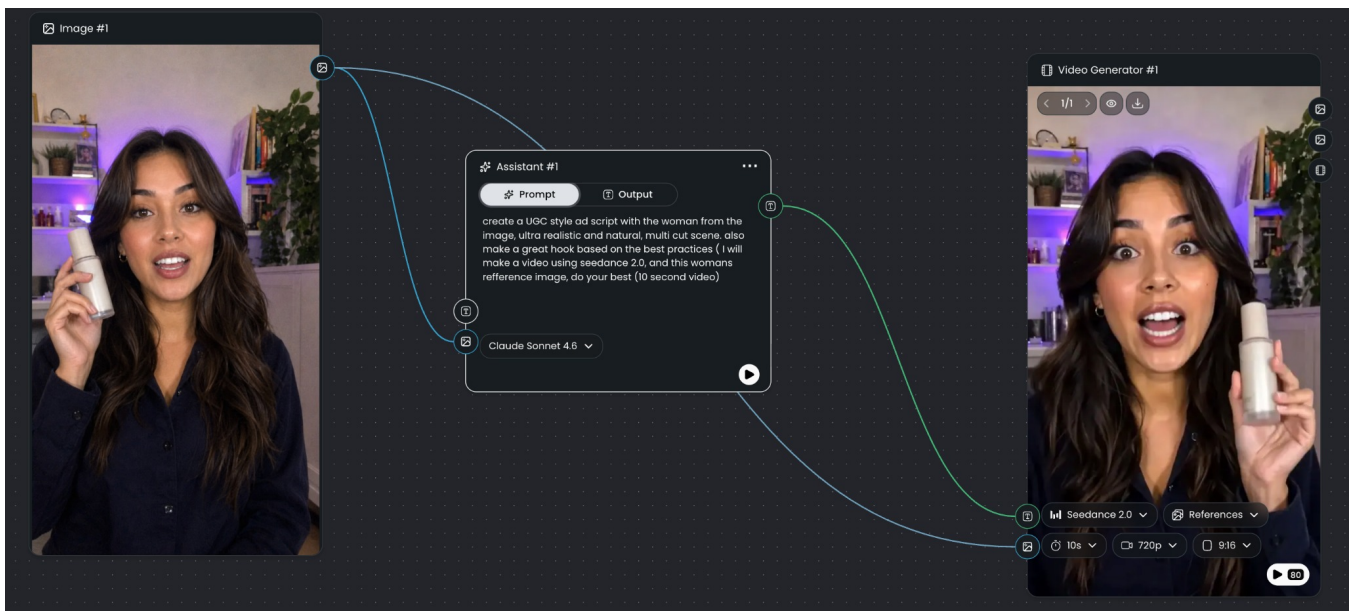
- Model: Seedance 2.0
- Aspect ratio: 9:16 for TikTok, Reels, Shorts, and Pinterest video pins.
- Duration: 10 seconds for faster hook tests, 15 seconds for fuller UGC ad scenes.
- Resolution: 720p is enough for testing. Upscale only the best results.

FAST UGC SHOT FORMULA

Use this structure when prompting Seedance through the Assistant output.

15 SECOND BEAT STRUCTURE

- 0-2s: big hook, creator leans toward camera holding the product.
- 2-5s: quick cut to product close-up, creator says what problem it solves.
- 5-8s: funny interruption or exaggerated reaction to create pattern break.
- 8-12s: creator explains the main benefit in casual UGC style.
- 12-15s: final close-up, clear CTA, confident reaction, product centered.

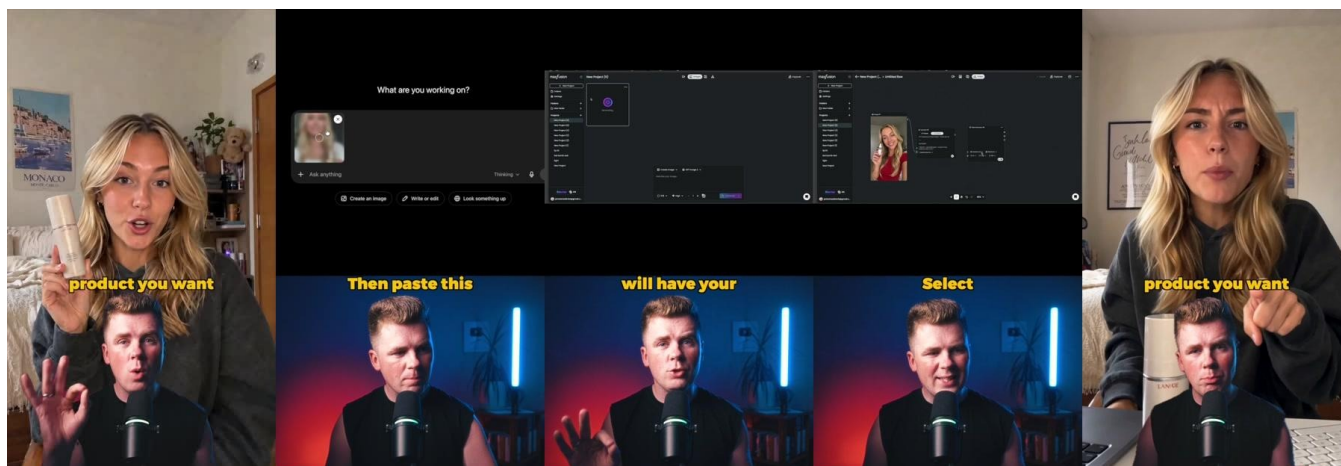


Example: an unexpected background character creates a strong pattern interrupt.

QUALITY CHECKLIST

What makes the result look ultra-realistic instead of AI-generated.

- Keep the reference image realistic: normal room, normal lighting, phone-camera framing.
- Make the product easy to see in the first 2 seconds.
- Ask for natural creator speech, quick cuts, hand movement, facial reactions, and small imperfections.
- Do not over-prompt cinematic camera moves. UGC works best when it feels like a normal creator filmed it herself.
- Generate multiple versions. Pick the one where the face, hands, product label, and movement look most believable.
- Add captions later in CapCut, Final Cut Pro, or your short-form editing workflow.



Video notes: start with product, paste the image prompt, select Seedance/video settings, generate variations.

COPY-PASTE MASTER PROMPT

Use this inside Maxfusion Assistant for new UGC ad variations.

MASTER ASSISTANT PROMPT
Create an ultra-realistic UGC-style AI video ad based on the uploaded creator image/reference. The creator is holding and explaining the PRODUCT. Make it feel like a real TikTok/Reels phone video, not a commercial. Start with a strong hook in the first second. Use many quick cuts, product close-ups, natural facial reactions, hand movements, and casual creator dialogue. Add one funny unexpected moment or pattern interrupt while she is explaining why the product is great. Keep the product visible and important throughout. Make the scene energetic, attention-grabbing, and believable. 9:16 vertical video, 10-15 seconds, realistic indoor lighting, natural UGC camera movement, clear ending with a simple CTA.

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
